NO OUTSIDE FOOD or BEVERAGE is to be taken into the Baird

Please note that this F&B rule is the policy of the Baird. Security will not let you in with food. Exceptions are made for children with allergies.

Our competitions will be taking place on the third and fourth floors:

Stages A - C will be in the exhibit halls on the 3rd floor.

Stages D - F will be in the Baird Ballrooms on the 4th floor.

The Baird Center will be open to the public for our event during the following times:

The Baird Center will be accessible to enter by four main entrances:

- 1. The Skywalk between the Hyatt Regency & the Baird
 - 2. The Skywalk between the Hilton & the Baird
- 3. The main North Entrance to the building (which is 405 Kilbourn)
- 4. The main South Entrance to the building (which is 400 Wisconsin)

HOTELS

We have TWO flagship host hotels: Hilton & Hyatt Regency.

Some things to note about each of these properties:

HILTON: 509 W Wisconsin Ave

- The Hilton is connected to the South side of the Baird Center via a skywalk that connects to the hotel on its third floor.
- The escalators to the third-floor sky walk are not currently operational (they are being refurnishes). Stairs are an option, and all elevators are working.

HYATT REGENCY: 333 W Kilbourn Ave

• The Hyatt is connected to the North side of the Baird Center via a skywalk that connects to the hotel on its second floor.

Practice Rooms

There is a public practice space at the Baird Center in N206B/C

This is a 3,000 sq ft room that any competitor is allowed to access while the Baird Center is open. It will have a practice floor with Marley for dancers to use for practicing and warming up.

This is a shared space. Be respectful of others.

Additionally, every hotel contracted within our block has a <u>public practice space</u>. If you are staying at *any* of the hotels in our block, there is a room where you can go to stretch, practice, or even get ready in the morning (ie hair/makeup) at *every hotel property*. Again, these are shared spaces. Be respectful of others.

Kid's Wicked-Theme Party

This is a ticketed event. No tickets will be sold at the door. The party is from 6:30 – 8:30pm in the Hyatt - Regency Ballrooms A/B. Ticket sales have now closed.

Teen Karaoke Party

This is a ticketed event. No tickets will be sold at the door. The party is from 8 – 11pm at Amped, 910 W Juneau Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53233. Ticket sales have now closed.

Adult Party

Unfortunately, this party has been cancelled due to low ticket sales.

Sideline Squad

This is a perfect way to keep siblings of competitors busy while you focus on your dancer. You must purchase a camp time directly through their site: <u>Sideline Squad</u>. Located in S203D at the Baird Center.

No Dance Zone

This is a perfect quiet space to get away from the craziness. Absolutely no listening to Irish dance music, no practicing, nor getting ready (hair/makeup) in this space. It's a lounge area for those who need a break. Located in the MKE Market Lounge on the first floor of the Baird Center (directly inside the North Entrance).

Pre-Awards Show

Each competition day will feature a 30-60 minute pre-award show to keep your family entertained while you wait for that highly anticipated awards presentation! Please keep in mind that families are kindly asked not to save entire rows or sections of chairs for the awards ceremony.

COMPETITION PROTOCOLS

Numbers/Programs

There are no numbers printed in the program. Competitors are still listed in dance order, but the numbers will not be included. There is a box provided for you to fill in the numbers once they are released. The first dancer is notated for each round to allow you to plan your morning accordingly. At 7:15am on Friday/Sunday, and at 7:45am on Saturday, the competitor lists with competitor numbers and start numbers will be posted online. You can visit GoFeis, IDTAMA website, or social media to find these list. These will only be posted after judges have been sequestered. After the lists are posted, check online to find your number. *Once you know your number*, then collect your number at the stage where you compete.

Number Check

There will be a number check for solo championship competitions only (round 1 & 2). The check will be after every 30 dancers or at the completion of a small competition.

Recalls

All recalls, prior to being read aloud in the hall, shall be released and posted online by GoFeis and IDTAMA website immediately following tabulations. (Please note that the traditional set recalls will not be posted until after ceili competitions have concluded to allow those dancers to focus on their team events).

Awards

The solo and team award ceremonies will go back and forth on stages A & C. The running order of award presentations will be published closer to awards each evening. The awards will also be streamed on FeisTV.

Traditional Set awards are scheduled for 3:30pm on stages A, B, & C.

Saving seats will not be allowed during the pre-awards show or during the awards presentations.

FeisTV

FeisTV will be streaming the Mid-America Oireachtas! You can watch all the dancing and results online and friends at home can follow the action. Visit <u>feistv.com</u> to purchase a personal pass. Disclaimer: Consent through entry. By entering and participating, competitors (or their legal guardians) consent to being filmed, photographed, recorded, and broadcast by FeisTV for live streaming, promotional, archival, and related purposes.

RULES

Syllabus

A complete listing of the syllabus event rules can be found <u>here.</u> By participating in the event, you acknowledge and accept these rules.

Makeup Rule

A friendly reminder that competitors in Under 8, Under 9, and Under 10 events are prohibited from wearing makeup or false eyelashes per the Rules of An Coimisiún.

Seating at the Event

The front two rows at all competition stages are reserved for teachers.

Additionally, no seat-saving will be allowed. We kindly ask that you please do not reserve whole rows of chairs by placing your items on chairs. The chairs at the event are meant to be sat in, and anyone found to be saving entire sections of chairs (even before awards ceremonies) will be asked to remove their items from the chairs so that attendees may utilize the available seating. Thank you for your attention to this.

No Wristbands required to enter the event

Attendees will have free access to the Baird Center during designated hours.

Costuming & Carriage Aids

Current CLRG rules will be applied and enforced. You can refer to the CLRG Rule Book, which includes a ban on any non-medically prescribed devices.

Mischief

Any person caught damaging property (whether private property or that of a hotel/venue of that of the IDTAMA) will be requested to leave the premises immediately and will not be permitted to attend any remaining events at these Championships. All parties will be billed for damages. Parents/guardians will be fully responsible for the whereabouts and the actions of their children. The IDTAMA will not be held responsible for personal injury, property damage, theft, loss, or any claim.

Filming/Recording

The use of any device that is capable of taking videos will not be permitted during competitions.

Decisions

All decisions made by the MAO 2025 Committee, the IDTAMA executive board, and/or the adjudicators for the event, in accordance with the rules for the event at the competition syllabus, will be final.

Set & Speed Verification

For dancers competing in the solo championship events, your set dance and speed will be printed on the back of your number card. When you collect your number card in the morning, please check to ensure accuracy. If the set/speed are listed incorrectly, please notify the stage monitor so that they can update the list well in advance of the set rounds.

Falls on Stage

Where a dancer is injured and medical attention is necessary, an athletic trainer from Children's Hospital of Wisconsin Sports Medicine (a team will be on-site) to address the needs.

If in the opinion of the stage steward, having obtained medical advice if necessary, a dancer is unfit to re-dance and if such a dancer insists on his/her right to do so, then the dancer concerned will only be permitted to re-dance on completion of a declaration form exonerating IDTAMA of liability for any consequences. This waiver must be signed by the parent of the dancer (or the dancer him/herself if over 18).

- Donated items cannot have additional labels, stickers, logos or attachments. This includes messaging from charities or other not-for-profit organizations.
- Please keep items to a "grab-and-go" size (no larger than 18" tall)
- We care for kids who may have experienced significant violence or trauma. All donations must be free from violent themes.
- We promote the social, dental, physical and mental health of those who we serve. All donations should support healthy habits.
- We care for kids and families of all religious and spiritual backgrounds and beliefs. All donated items must be free from both generic and specific religious or spiritual themes or messages.
- To keep our patients safe, especially those with food allergies or special dietary needs, we are unable to accept food items of any kind.
- Donation requests and items that will be declined:
 - o Beanie babies

 - Vending machine toys
 - Dollar store items
 - o Outdoor activities (skateboards, pogo sticks, water toys, etc).
