



High School/College Scholarship Application Guidelines

The Irish Dance Teachers Association of Mid America is proud of the accomplishments of all dancers not only competitively and artistically, but also academically. To recognize the accomplishments of dancers who excel in the classroom and in the dance studio, the IDTAMA is proud to offer academic scholarships for applicants meeting the following guidelines:

- The applicant is a high school senior graduating in Spring 2024 and planning to attend a four-year undergraduate college or university, OR is enrolled in a four-year undergraduate college program who will and planning to continue enrollment during the 2023-2024 school year.
- The applicant is enrolled in and actively participating in Irish dance classes at a Mid-America dance school. Teacher(s) must be active and registered with CLRG and IDTANA.
- Applicants under the age of 18 must apply with the permission of a parent or guardian.

Application and Review Timeline:

- Applications open September 1st, 2023.
- Applications close Monday, January 15, 2024 (11:59pm EST).
- Winners will be announced by May 15, 2024.

Please follow the directions below in order to submit your application. All documents will be submitted through the [Google form](#).

- All documents submitted must be in PDF format.
- All required materials must be submitted BY THE APPLICANT.
Schools/counselors/teachers may not submit materials separately. Get copies from your school to submit the required files (remember that unofficial copies are acceptable).
- All documents must be submitted at the same time through the Google form.



- The deadline for submission is **Monday, January 15th 2024 (11:59pm EST)**. Any submissions past this date will not be considered. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- The following **FIVE** documents are required:
 1. **TRANSCRIPT**: A **copy of your most recent transcript** showing final grades for all high school courses through the end of the most recent semester/trimester. In other words, all final grades from 9th-11th grade for high school, or 9-12th grade for college. You may use an unofficial or official copy of the transcript. **This should be uploaded as a single document in PDF format.** Please title the document with your initials followed by Transcript (example: NGM-Transcript).
 2. **TEST SCORES**: A copy of your most recent SAT and/or ACT scores. **This must be uploaded as a SINGLE document in PDF format.** Please title the document with your initials followed by Testing (example: NGM-Testing).
 3. **RESUME**: A “resume” listing involvement and accomplishments outside of academics. Please note, this does not need to be a formal resume, but it must include sections a, b and c listed below. Each section should have a clear section header and each section should be a maximum of one page in a minimum of a 10-point font. **This should be uploaded as a single document in PDF or Google docs format.** Please title the document with your initials followed by Resume (example: NGM-Resume).
 - a. A bulleted list of your involvement and accomplishments in Irish dancing. This should include competitive level (if applicable), major competitions/awards, etc., as well as non-competitive experiences.
 - b. A bulleted list of your extracurricular activities during high school and/or college, including any positions of leadership held. Be very specific in describing/detailing leadership roles and responsibilities. This may include sports, clubs, and activities that are sponsored by your academic school, as well as those sponsored by churches or community organizations.
 - c. A bulleted list/description of any volunteer or service work, as well as any paid work, in which you have been involved during high school and/or college. Be very specific in describing/detailing roles and responsibilities of position.
 4. **IRISH DANCE TEACHER RECOMMENDATION**: Provide a brief letter from your Irish dance teacher which supports your scholarship application. This must be an original letter, written for this specific application on personal or



dance school letterhead, signed by the teacher, who must be a currently registered, certified TMRF/TCRG/ADCRG with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha and the IDTANA. This letter may not be any longer than one page (front only). **This must be uploaded as a SINGLE document in PDF format.** Please title the document with your initials followed by Recommendation (example: NGM-Recommendation).

5. **ESSAY:** For the prompt described below, develop a well-written, well-supported essay that succinctly responds to the prompt. Be specific, provide examples and explanations, and focus your essay on what the prompt is asking you to discuss. Each essay is expected to display mechanical and structural accuracy.

Please note the following requirements:

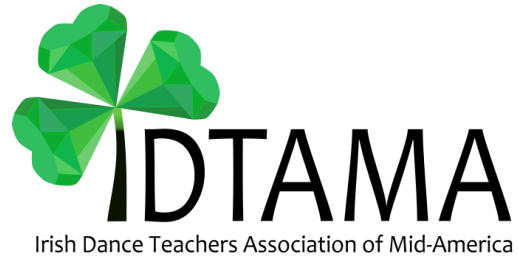
1. Your essay must be typed, double-spaced, and in a minimal font size of 10.
2. The two essays together should be no longer than two typed pages.
3. **This should be uploaded as a single document in PDF format**
4. Title your document with your initials followed by Essay (Example: NGM - Essay).

WRITING PROMPT

How has Irish dance impacted your life thus far, and how will you continue your Irish dance journey after high school/college?

The review of applications will occur as follows:

- **Any materials submitted after the submission deadline or by any other method or format than that described above will NOT be considered.**
- Applicants should receive an automated confirmation of receipt at the end of the Google form submission.
- All documents/materials submitted will be reviewed and ranked by a panel of scholarship committee members.
- Please note that all decisions are final and requests for information as to why an applicant did not receive a scholarship will not be addressed.
- Scholarships will be awarded in the following amounts for a total of \$10,000:
 - TWO College Awards - \$1500
 - FOUR High School Awards - \$1000
 - FOUR High School Awards - \$750
